KEY FEATURES

The Everyday-Life Practices and Skills Survey (e-PASS) is an assessment tool for measuring the literacy and numeracy skills of individuals aged 15 and older. It enables Member States to generate data for reporting on SDG 4 indicator 4.6.1.

Accessible

The application is available in four languages (English, Arabic, Spanish and French). It can be downloaded for free (© Play Store and © Apple Store) and used on a smartphone or a tablet.

PASS

User-friendly

Survey respondents are provided with a unique identifier that allows them to access an intuitive user interface that makes it easy to navigate through a simple, interactive questionnaire. Using the touchscreen features, the respondent can fill in the questionnaire on the interviewer's or her/his own device.

Flexible

The application does not require a connection to the internet or a mobile network to be used. The answers to the questionnaires are automatically transferred to the monitoring platform when a connection is available.


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Professional
